The interoperability governmental platform, known as MConnect, facilitates the exchange of data between authorities to increase the efficiency and quality of public services delivery.

Via MConnect, public authorities exchange data in real-time, which helps to:

- increase the efficiency and effectiveness of information delivered via electronic public services;
- increase the effectiveness of public funds;
- increase the security of information systems;
- reuse the resources available in existing information systems;
- improve collaboration between public administration institutions.
