

PLATAFORMA DE INTEROPERABILIDAD (PDI)

Facilitating the integration of digital government services, PDI is optimizing interaction between state entities through a service-oriented architecture.

NATIONAL ELECTRONIC HEALTH RECORD (HCEN)

A system that enables access to, and recording of, medical events, ensuring continuity of care and interoperability among healthcare providers.


NATIONAL ELECTRONIC CERTIFICATION INFRASTRUCTURE

A technical and regulatory framework for the development of a digital signature ecosystem in the country. Serving as the foundation for the development of digital processes and services in both the public and private sectors, making it easier for individuals to verify their identity and interact with various services.

Currently, Uruguay's digital ID registry has more than 1,600,000 registered users. According to Agesic's statistics, 1 in 2 Uruguayans over the age of 18 has an account. More than 180 organizations are integrated, and on average more than 85,000 daily authentications are performed on business days.

My Digital Medical Record is an application that allows individuals that are part of the National Integrated Health System (SNIS) to access their digital medical information which serves as the equivalent of a paper medical record. All users can configure permissions and privacy settings from any computer, tablet, or mobile phone.

Digital Signatures are allowing individuals to sign documents digitally in a simple and secure way, with the same legal value as a handwritten signature. Uruguay's advanced digital signature is valid throughout Argentina, and vice versa. Uruguay is currently extending this to Paraguay and Brazil.
