

DIGITAL IDENTITY

PILOTING AND PLANNING

Biometric platforms like **MyID** and **UzFace** enable secure and efficient authentication across various sectors.

MyID allows citizens to link personal information, including transport cards and government services, to a unified digital identity, and is widely used by government agencies, banks, and e-commerce platforms for seamless access to services.

UzFace currently in its pilot phase, is a facial recognition system being integrated into both public and private sectors to streamline identity verification for banks, payment systems, and other services.

Uzbekistan's **Open Data Portal** provides access to over 9100 datasets, which is helping to serve as the foundation of open public administration and development of future DPI.

DIGITAL PAYMENTS

IMPLEMENTING

The Government of Uzbekistan is driving the digitalization of its economy by supporting the development of electronic payment systems.

Regulatory measures ensure the secure use of electronic financial services, and the **Unified Billing System**, now facilitates over 1,100 payments, duties, and fees for nearly 600 services provided by 70 state agencies. This system offers real-time payment processing and a unique, non-repeating invoice for each transaction, streamlining public services and administrative payments.
